

### General Terms and Conditions:

1. NO Visa, NO Fee offer refers to Origin Migration professional fee amounting to PHP50,000 for acting, preparing and/or organising your enrolment, visa application and others matter related to your Australian visa application.
2. NO IELTS, you will have to seat WAIFS alternative English language competency test online to ensure your ability to learn in an English language education institution.
3. NO Show Money, meaning we will not require you to provide a certain amount of money, but it is our responsibility to ensure that you have the means to support yourself in studying in Australia.
4. The online self-paced study is a maximum of 3 subjects while waiting for the Australian border to reopen and to finalise your visa application.
5. Tuition fee is not refundable amounting to AU\$1230, if the student visa application is refused, the student will get a certificate of attainment for the three subjects issued by WAIFS.
6. As an Australian student visa holder, you are entitled to work 40 hours per fortnight and unlimited hours during the school break.
7. Opportunity for a work visa if you have a formal qualification and minimum of two years of work experience as a Cook or Chef prior studying in Australia, three years of relevant experience may substitute for the formal qualification

9. Work fulltime in Australia for 18 months after course completion offer is the Australian graduate visa subclass 485 for eligibility refer to this link - <https://immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-listing/temporary-graduate-485/graduate-work>.
